

REPORT ON HVT MALAYSIA

ASSUNTA SCHOOL PROGRAMME FOR YEAR 2014/2015

The last report ("2013/2014 report") that was issued was dated 13 January 2014.

A. ASSUNTA PRIMARY SCHOOL PROGRAMME("HVTASP(P)")

(1) Financial Report

(a) Total No. of Students

We had a total of 41 students, of which 27 were new students. Please see **Appendix 1** (list of the students).

(b) School kit

We continued to provide the school kit as previous years to the students. There has been no change on the contents of the school kits that were provided. However due to rising costs, the prices for the items have increased.

(c) Food Programme

The same as previous years. Please find attached (**Appendix 2**) the menu of the food provided to the students during recess. Most of the kids continue to take food under the programme.

(d) Income and Expenditure for 2013

We had some balance **RM13,149.67** as at 31 December 2013 carried forward into 2014 and received two further contributions from the UK Trust during the year amounting **RM11,034.84 (RM11,039.84 less RM5 for banking charges)** in February and **RM22,366.37** in December 2014, giving us a total of **RM46,550.88**.

The **total expenses** in 2014 was **RM20,095.10**. The average amount spent on each child for the whole year was **RM490.12**.

(2) Tutorial and Academic Report for 2012

The Tutorial and Academic Report for what has been done/achieved for last year, as prepared by Zuli Ghaus is attached here as **Appendix 4**.

B. ASSUNTA SECONDARY SCHOOL PROGRAMME ("HVTASP(S)")

(1) General Progress

Following from last year's report:

- (i) we commenced with the giving out of school kits to children entering Secondary 1, 4 of them, totaling expenses of **RM780.00**; and

- (ii) we commenced with the food programme for all children under HVTASP(S) from Secondary 1 to 3, totaling 13 of them.

We are still in discussions on the tutorial programme which has not made much progress as we still have difficulties sorting out:

- (i) sourcing of tutors/volunteers (especially with Jessie's withdrawal from the primary tuition programme); and
- (ii) transport requirements to/from tuition

So pending resolution on the tuition issue, we will only be able to continue with the school kit and food programme for HVTASP(S) for 2015.

(2) Financial Report

(a) Total No. of Students

We had a total of 13 students for secondary, (ranging from Secondary 1 to 3), most of whom are from the primary programme.

(b) School kit

We continue to provide school kits as per last year which only consisted of school uniform.

(c) Food Programme

We started with the food programme for secondary commencing in February.

(d) Income and Expenditure

The total expense for secondary was RM5,292.00 averaging RM407.10 per child.

Please refer to **Appendix 3** for further details.

As at 31 Dec 2014, we have a **total balance** of **RM18,828.68** after expenses for HVTASP(P) and HVTASP(S).

Please see the full details of the income/expenditure for the 54 children under the HVTASP(P) and HVTASP(S) in **Appendices 3, 3(a) and 3(b)**.

(3) Academic Report

We have obtained exam results for the first time and have not had any previous results to be able to gauge their academic progress. We will provide a report based on mid-year examinations in 2015.

C. BUDGET REQUIREMENT OF 2015

For academic year 2015, there will be 43 children under the HVTASP(P) and 19 children under HVTASP(S), totaling 62.

With the 2014 balance of **RM18,828.68** less the amount of **RM13,143.00** which will have to be expended towards the school kits that were handed out to the children on 6 December 2014, we would have a balance of **RM5,685.68** in the accounts available for this year.

Based on an average of RM500.00 per child for HVTASP(P) and RM800.00 per child for HVTASP(S) for the food programme and an additional amount of approximately RM900.00 for tuition materials (for Primary only), it is estimated that the budget requirement for 2015 will be a total of RM37,600.00 calculated as follows:

Primary - RM2.50 X 200 school days per year = RM500.00 (per pupil per year)
43 pupils X RM500.00 = RM21,500.00

Secondary - RM4.00 X 200 school days per year = RM800.00 (per pupil per year)
19 pupils X RM800.00 = RM15,200.00

Tuition Materials = RM900.00

Total = RM37,600.00 (app. £7,520.00 (@£1-RM5))

We would like to request the amount be disbursed to us in two instalments of £2,506 each and a final instalment of £2,508. May we suggest such disbursements to be made at the end of March, June and September 2015.

Should we implement the tuition programme for HVTASP(S) some time this year we will report to the UK Trust and seek your approval for additional budget prior to such implementation.

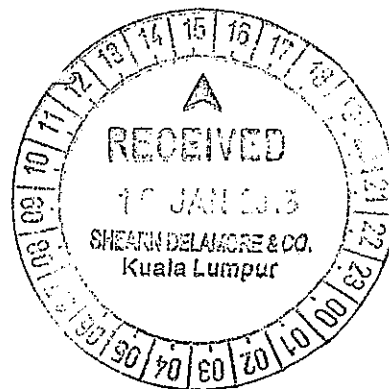

HVT TUITION PROGRAMME 2014

Overview

The HVT programme for 2014 registered a total number of 41 students.

The tuition programme is conducted on a weekly basis every Thursday at the school premises. In 2014, classes commenced on 13th February continuing over the ensuing 26 weeks, taking into account school holidays and public holidays, with the final session on 2nd October 2014. Tutoring classes were conducted from 10.15am-12.45pm before school hours and students were provided with lunch after classes. As has been the practice, Standard 6 students are additionally tutored on Mondays from the second term in preparation for a national exam in September.

Standards 2, 3 & 4 students receive tutoring in Math & English. Standard 5 students receive tutoring in Math, English and Science and Standard 6 the same but with additional guidance in Malay Language. Eleven tutors assisted in the programme this year, namely:

Academic

The mid-year and year end reports are attached and reflected in separate tables for Lower Primary (Standards 2 & 3) and Upper Primary (Standards 4, 5 & 6).

Also attached are the UPSR Results (Markah Murid UPSR HVT 2014). This would be the national examinations that Standard 6 students sit for. Four of the 11 students had one or more Grade D or E. A single or more D or E grade means the student has failed the exam. This however does not affect their promotion to Form 1 (Secondary School) the following year. The UPSR examinations 2014 were marred by leakages that were uncovered after the exams. This resulted in students nationwide resitting the Math, Science and English papers which was widely reported in the media to be disruptive and demoralising for the students causing them to 'lose interest' during the resits.

Thulasi of Standard 6 was awarded the Most Improved Student in her class at year end awards.

Attendance

The total average group attendance per session for the year was 27 out of a total 41 students with the average attendance per individual student standing at 66%.

Inconsistent attendance is again a challenge for the teachers to cover the syllabus at hand and ensure students have achieved a desirable level of competency. This also because the 26 sessions or so a year would only just be sufficient to cover the subject topics provided there is full attendance.

Intervention Measures

This year we shall again focus on parental involvement in helping to improve motivation levels and diligence amongst the students. We had not fully adopted the measure prescribed in the 2013 to make weekly calls to the parents requiring them to look into both the school and HVT assigned homework whilst ensuring the students have dedicated time set aside at home for revision. Simple incentives in the form of stickers, new erasers, chocolates or even a Rm1/- gold coin for rewarding a sum well done, reading or correct spelling proved effective.
