## Phil Wang Comedian/Headliner

Phil Wang is a British-Malaysian stand-up comedian. Born in Stoke on Trent, he grew up in Kota Kinabala, Malaysia before moving back to the UK as a teenager, where he attended Cambridge University. He is a member of the sketch group Daphne, with whom he created the BBC 4 radio series *Daphne Sounds Expensive*. As a solo performer, he has toured five acclaimed stand-up shows across the globe, and has appeared on *Live at the Apollo* (BBC2), *Have I Got News For You* (BBC1), *Would I Lie to You?* (BBC1), *8 Out of 10 Cats Does Countdown* (C4), *The Great British Bake Off: Extra Slice* (C4), and *Jack Dee's Helpdesk* (BBC2). In 2017, he headlined the Harinder Veriah Trust's first ever comedy night, ABC 1.

## Baluji Shrivastav OBE Sitarist

Baluji Shrivastav OBE is an Indian-British multi-instrumentalist. Working in the Hindustani classical tradition, he is a master of sitar, surbahar, dilruba, pakhavaj and tabla, crediting his blindness with spurring him to excel in musical artistry and technique. As a sitarist, he has worked with artists as diverse as Stevie Wonder, Coldplay, Massive Attack, Madness, and Annie Lennox. He has performed all over the world, including at the closing ceremony of the UK Paralympic Games in 2012, and is the founder of the Baluji Music Foundation, which encourages the participation of disabled people in music. In 2016 he was awarded an OBE for services to music in the Queen's 90th birthday honours.
